Four times this year, you will have a chance to exchange 5 inch charm squares. <u>Registration</u> <u>ends at the January meeting so I can get an accurate count of how many charms to bring</u>. I will let you know before February how many charms to bring and the approximate yardage you will need.

**The first exchange will be at the February meeting.** Bring a Valentine box or paper sack (decorated would be fun)—with your name is on it. We will have tables for the boxes. At break, you will put one of your charms in each box, and at the end of the meeting you will take home all the charms placed in your box.

Be sure to cut your squares precisely and on grain. While the color for each exchange fits the season, the fabric you cut for charms (solids or prints) does not have to be holiday themed.


February: bring red or pink charms
